
## Route description:

## Dear sir or madam, Dear colleagues,

since 2011 we are carrying out the project "Culturally sensitive patient information for patients with a migration background and a chronic disease" (KULTINFO), which is supported by the Federal Ministry of Education and Research. The aim of the project is to examine whether culturally sensitive patient information has a higher subjective value than standard-translated information.

In this respect, in the first step the culturally sensitive patient information material for patients with a Turkish, Polish or Italian migration background as well as (late) resettlers from the former Soviet Union and a diagnosis of depressive disorder or chronic lower back pain were developed. Next the culturally sensitive patient information materials were evaluated in the framework of a double-blind randomized-controlled parallel group study in four study centers in Germany (Freiburg/Lörrach; Leipzig; Hamburg; Oberhausen/Mülheim/Duisburg).

At the end of the project we are organizing this international symposium with guests from Italy, Poland, Russia and Turkey and we are looking forward to stimulating discussions.
